CROCHET DOLL

Hair

chain 10, turn
sc 9, chain 1, turn (9)
sl 3, dc 2, sl 1, tc 3 (9)
chain 1. sc up along the
BACK HALF of the piece,
until you meet the start
of the chain.

(add 2 sc to the corner.
You can sc 3 along the side
of the triple crochet stitch.)

Mouth

chain 8, turn
sc 3, SKIP 1 stitch, sc 3. Tie off.

Head

1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
2: 6 inc (12)
3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 6 (18)
4: (2 sc, 1 inc)x 6 (24)
5: (3 sc, 1 inc)x 6 (30)
6: (4 sc, 1 inc)x 6 (36)
7-11: 36 sc (5 rounds total) (36)
12: (2 sc, 1 dec)x 9 (27)
13: In front loops only, 27 sc (27)
14-16: 27 sc (27)
17: (2 sc, 1 dec)x 6, 1 sc, 1 dec (20)
Stuff piece here.
18: 10 dec (10)
19: 5 dec (5)
tie off, leave tail to sew shut.

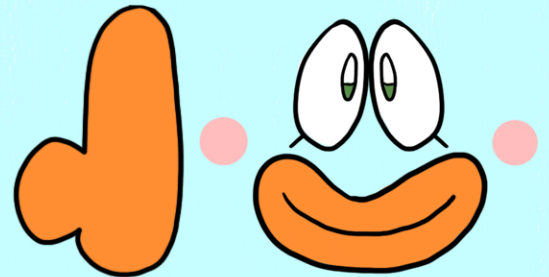
Hook size used: 5 mm

For this pattern, I used Loops and Threads soft classic acrylic in white, aqua, and safety orange, as well as Loops and Threads impeccable acrylic in clear blue. For simplicity, I will refer to the colours as white, orange, light blue, and medium blue.

Feel free to redistribute this pattern, just don't sell it I guess.
You can sell the dolls you make, though.

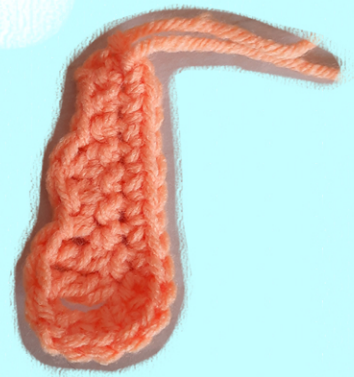
LEGEND:

sc- single crochet
dc - double crochet
tc - triple crochet
sl - slip stitch
flo - front loops only



For the face, you can use safety eyes and yarn, or a variety of other materials. Felt, craft foam, etc, to get a more character accurate look.

If you are using safety eyes, add them between rows 13 and 14, 5 sc apart



Legs

Start in med blue

Chain 7

1: Turn, 6 sc, working on opposite

side of chain- 5 sc, 1 inc (13)

2: 1 inc, 4 sc, 3 sl, 4 sc, 1 inc (15)

3: 15 sc (15)

4: 7 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc (14)

5: 6 sc, 2 dec, 4 sc, (12)

6: 6 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc (11)

7: 11 sc (11)

8: 1 sc, 2 inc, 8 sc (13)

9: 13 sc (13)

10: (1 scm 1 inc)x 2, 9 sc (15)

11: 15 sc (15)

12: 3 sc, change colour to light blue, 12 sc (15)

13: 15 sc (15)

14: 4 sc, change colour to white, 11 sc (15)

15: 4 sc, 2 inc, 9 sc (17)

16: 5 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc (19)

17-21: 19 sc (5 rounds) (19)

22: (1 sc, 1 dec)x 6, 1 sc (13)

Stuff lower leg firmly. Stuff upper leg lightly.

23: 6 dec, leave last stitch unworked (7)

Tie off, sew shut. Leave LONG tail (12 inch) on one leg.



Arms

Start in white

1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

2: (1 sc, 1 inc)x 3 (9)

3: (2 sc, 1 inc)x 3 (12)

4-8: 12 sc (5 rounds) (12)

9: (4sc, 1 dec)x 2 (10)

10-11: 10 sc (2 rounds) (10)

Change color to light blue

12-13: 10 sc (2 rounds) (10)

Change colour to medium blue

14-16: 10 sc (3 rounds) (10)

Stuff piece here

17: (1 sc, 1 dec)x 3, sc in last stitch (7)

Tie off, sew shut. Leave LONG tail

(~12 inches) on one of the arms.



Body

Start in light blue

- 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
- 2: 6 inc (12)
- 3: (1 sc, 1 inc)x6 (18)
- 4: (2 sc, 1 inc)x 6 (24)
- 5: (3 sc, 1 inc)x 6, (30)
- 6: (4 sc, 1 inc)x6 (36)
- 7-12 36 sc (6 rounds) (36)
- 13: (4 sc, 1 dec)x6 (30)
- 14: (3 sc, 1 dec)x 6 (24)
- 15: (2 sc, 1 dec)x 6 (18)
- 16: Front loops only: (2 sc, 1 inc)x6 (24)
- 17: 3 sc, 1 inc, change colour to medium blue, (3 sc, 1 inc)x 4, change colour to light blue, 3 sc, 1 inc (30)
- 18: 4 sc, change colour to medium blue, 1 inc, (4 scm 1 inc)x 4, 1 sc, change colour to light blue, 3 sc, 1 inc (36)
- 19: 3 sc, change colour to medium blue, 30 sc, change colour to light blue, 3 sc (36)
- 20: 2 sc, change colour to medium blue, 33 sc, change colour to light blue, 1 sc (36)
- 21: 2 sc, change colour to medium blue, 34 sc (36)
- 22: 36 sc (36)
- 23: (4 sc, 1 dec)x 6 (30)
- 24: (3 sc, 1 dec)x 6 (24)

Stuff here

- 25: (2sc, 1 dec)x 6, (18)
- 26: (1 sc, 1 dec)x 6 (12)

Cut and tie off. Leave long tail, do not sew shut.



Hat

Rows 1-25 will be worked in the round.

Rows 26-43 will be in back and forth rows

- 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)
- 2: 6 sc (6)
- 3: 1 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc (7)
- 4: 7 sc (7)
- 5: 1 sc, 2 inc, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc (8)
- 6: 1 sc, 3 inc, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc (10)
- 7: 1 sc, 4 inc, 2 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc (13)
- 8: 13 sc (13)
- 9: 3 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)x 2, 6 sc (15)
- 10: 15 sc (15)
- 11: (2 sc, 1 inc)x5 (20)
- 12: 20 sc (20)
- 13: (4 sc, 1 inc)x4 (24)
- 14: 24 sc (24)
- 15: 8 sc, 5 dec, 6 sc (19)
- 16: 7 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc (16)
- 17: 6 sc, 5 inc, 5 sc (21)
- 18: 7 sc, 8 inc, 6 sc (29)
- 19-20: 29 sc (2 rounds) (29)
- 21: 10 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)x6, 7 sc (35)
- 22-25: 35 sc (4 rounds) (35)

Here we will start working in rows

- 26: 10 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)x 4, 12 sc, ch 1, turn (35)
 - 27-29: sc 35, ch 1, turn (3 rows) (35)
 - 30: 11 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)x 4, 16 sc, ch1, turn (39)
 - 31-35: 39 sc, ch1, turn (5 rows) (39)
 - 36: (6 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 5 sc, 1 dec, ch1, turn (34)
 - 37: 34 sc, ch 1, turn (34)
 - 38: (5 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 3 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, ch 1, turn (29)
 - 39: (4 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 5 sc, ch 1, turn (25)
 - 40: (3 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 2 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, ch 1, turn (20)
 - 41: (2 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, ch 1, turn (15)
 - 42: (1 sc, 1 dec)x 4, 1 dec, 1 sc, ch 1, turn (10)
 - 43: 5 dec, ch 1 (5)
- sc around opening, trying to keep it under 40 stitches.
continue to sc around to bottom of opening.
change colour to light blue. sc around opening.
ch 1, dc around opening. sl into 1st dc at the end of the row. tie off, leave a long tail for sewing.
when stuffing, leave a divot where the head will fit.



Assembly instructions

Sew the head to the body

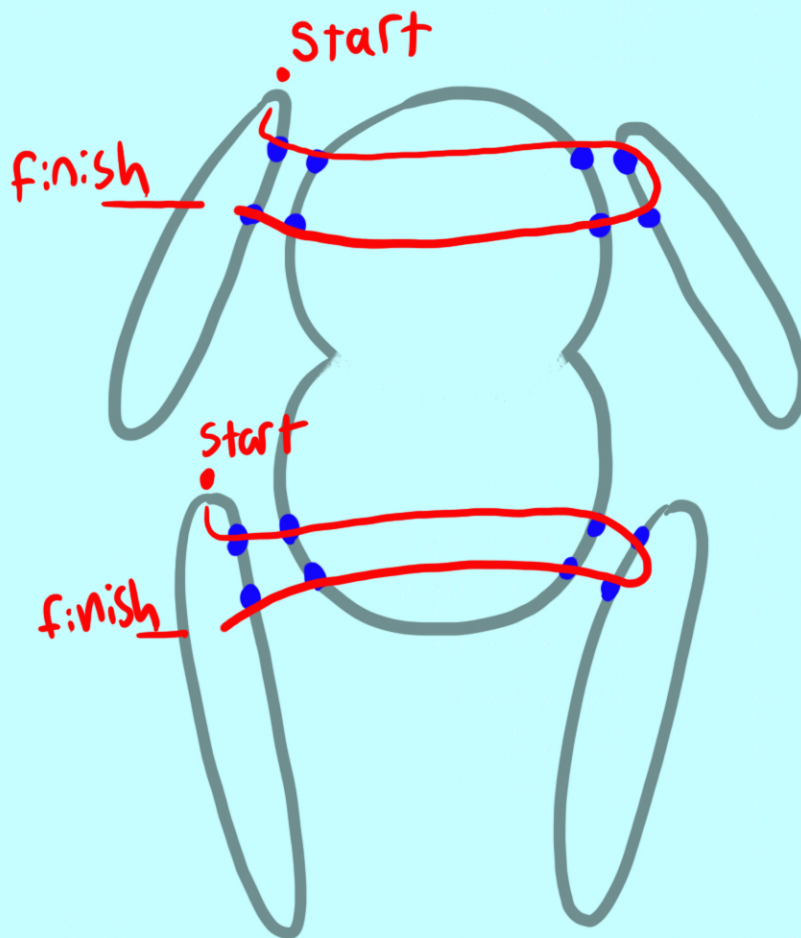
Sew the arms to the body

Sew the legs to the body

Sew the hair to the head

Sew the hat to the head
